Funding requirement

KV Smartflow is seeking grant funding (or blended grant + finance) to accelerate capacity, strengthen local supply resilience and scale BIM-enabled delivery.

- **Typical ask:** £50,000–£250,000 (grant-led or blended).
- **Implementation window:** 8–16 weeks from approval.
- **Location focus:** Northampton (West Northamptonshire).

Use of funds (example)

- Digital delivery: BIM software, hardware and QA tooling; secure BIM schedule upload and evidence pack workflow.
- Operational tools: testing equipment, calibrated instruments, safety kit and compliant storage.
- Premises enabling: racking/shelving, signage and fit-out enabling works (delivery base / trade counter model where applicable).
- People and skills: training, certifications, and early hires to increase throughput and quality control.

Headline outcomes

- **Capacity:** deliver more projects with consistent QA and clearer evidence trails.
- **Speed:** reduce programme and rework through BIM coordination.
- **Compliance:** governance, ESG and audit-ready delivery documentation.
- **Jobs:** create local employment and skills pathways in West Northamptonshire.

Measure	Target (illustrative)
Programme adherence	Improved on-time delivery through better coordination
Rework / defects	Reduced snagging and repeat visits
Response time	Faster call-out and planned maintenance completion
Local jobs & training	New hires and structured training hours delivered
